

# LSSC Defensive Multi Gun Match Safety Briefing

- This is a COLD RANGE. Do not load any firearms until you are instructed to do so by the Safety Officer.
- Handguns must remain in their holsters with the magazine removed and the hammer/striker down unless you are preparing to shoot or are engaged in a course of fire. You may handle an unholstered and unloaded handgun in any of the designated Safe Areas.
- Long guns must have chamber flags inserted unless you are preparing to shoot or are engaged in a course of fire. You may handle an unflagged and unloaded long gun in any of the designated Safe Areas.
- Do NOT handle any ammunition in the Safe Areas. You may have ammunition on your person in the Safe Areas, but you must not handle it under any circumstances.
- All spectators and match participants must wear eye protection at all times during the match.
- All spectators and match participants must wear hearing protection when they are in or around any of the shooting bays.
- The consumption of alcohol or drugs before or during the match is strictly forbidden. Alcohol or drugs are not permitted on range property.
- When you are engaged in a course of fire, keep the muzzle of your firearm pointed in a safe direction. Always observe the “180 Rule.”
- During a course of fire, keep your finger off the trigger unless you are engaging targets.
- Be sure to engage the safeties on long guns before abandoning them in Dump Tubes.
- Maintain control of your firearms at all times.
- Follow all commands issued by the Safety Officer.
- If anyone says “Cease Fire” or “Stop,” you should stop shooting, remain in place, and await further instructions from the Safety Officer.
- If you drop a loaded firearm, do not pick it up until instructed to do so by the Safety Officer.
